FINAL DIAGNOSIS

35% BURN WITH HOT OIL (FACE, CHEST, BOTH UPPER LIMB).

HISTORY

Baby. Alice, 03 years, old female, patient was admitted in this hospital with complaints of severe pain and burning sensation at burn site. Irritability, excessive crying.
A/H/O- Burn injury with hot oil while playing at home on 22/07/19 at 5:00PM. Burn on face, upper chest, eyes, both upper. She took initial treatment at kailash hospital then came here for further management.

ON EXAMINATION

GC - Sick, No Pallor, No Icterus, No cyanosis, No clubbing, No oedema.

Pulse - 120/Min R/S - B/L clear Temp - 98.4°F. CVS - S1S2 normal. CNS- NAD
PA - Soft, Bs+, NT. R/R - 22/Min. SPO2 - 99% GCS - 15/15

Burn injury on Face, Chest, Both upper limb.

INVESTIGATION

All the Investigation Reports are attached with Discharge Summary.

COURSE IN HOSPITAL

Patient admitted in hospital through casualty on 23.07.19 under Dr. Varun Kulshrestha with above mentioned history. All necessary investigations done as per as per standardised protocol treatment initiated with IV fluids, IV antibiotics, IV Analgesic and other supportive treatment given. After dressing patient shifted to ICU for close monitoring. Under all aseptic precautions dressing done on alternate days. Patient shifted to ward from ICU after stabilization. Physician referral (Dr. Saurabh Chaudhary) was done. Paediatrician referral (Dr. Nidhish) done. Eye referral (Dr. Rahul Bhargav) pus culture was sterile done. Gradually patient recovered. Now patient condition is stable and is being discharged with following advice and oral medicines.
